- Audio on the Internet.....
- Video on the Internet...vodcasting
- Accessible via downloading or RSS aggregation
- MP3 file format....playable on MP3 players such as an iPod, laptop, handheld computer

Ubiquitous Computing and Curriculum Integration

What does it take to achieve ubiquitous computing?

- A mobile computing environment: laptops and handhelds
- A wireless network to service devices and provide Intranet and Internet access
- A tech support department ready to cope with connectivity and other problems
- A desire to enhance student-centered learning and authentic assessment
- A practical approach to 'Just-in-Time' professional development and integration objectives

1-to-1 computing at ISD!

- Handheld Initiative For Education
- Laptop Initiative For Education
 - Using handhelds and laptops to access and share information via WLAN
 - Storing audio (MP3) files
 - Creating audio (MP3) files
 - Podcasting to enhance student directed learning

What can be done using Podcasting as a tool in a ubiquitous computing environment?

Ubiquitous Computing and Podcasting

Student-created podcasts for assessment, reflection, interaction, collaboration (aiming for 'real' dialogue and plagiarism avoidance rather than regurgitated material)

Some Podcast Bangladesh examples:

- Discussion and interaction on a global issue (e.g. digital divide)
- Online debate (local and global)
- Discussion and reflection about digital story development
- Curriculum-based interviews of and by students and teachers
